Main Text

- **Introduction**

The introduction should provide background information, often including a brief literature review, and clearly state the purpose of the article at the end.

- **Body text**

It consists of several coherent sections, with paragraphs logically connected to support the argument. The core lies in clear and logical reasoning, and the author may determine the structure independently, adding headings when necessary.

- **Discussion**

The discussion should summarize and reinforce the key arguments presented in the body of the paper. It must explore the implications of the ideas or perspectives discussed, while also addressing potential future research directions, limitations, or shortcomings of the study.
